



VoiceProof® – FAQ.

VoiceProof® is a software-only solution combining Scalable Strong Authentication with Advanced Electronic Signature and Crypto Applications..

1. What kind of software should user install?
The user should download and install VoiceProof® and VoiceShield® from SentryCom production web site.
2. What kind of content can be used with VoiceProof®?
Any content can be used: documents, forms, images , presentations , audio , video, executables...
3. Any size limitations?
The content should be less then ~200 MB .
4. What is the simplest usage of VoiceProof®?
Selecting content and using Encrypt option . One can e-mail encrypted content to other VoiceProof® user. Zero effort for the sender and zero effort for the recipient.
5. Is it secure enough?
Not enough - in many cases. To be more secure - you need some extra effort. You need to apply Seal option on top.
6. Can you elaborate?
Seal option requires that recipient be authenticated in real-time.
7. Can I seal this content for specific recipient only?
You have multiple options: you can seal it for specific recipient, for a number of specific recipients or for any recipient, registered at SentryCom – all options require real-time strong authentication.

For example: you are in the Internet Café, have no means of authentication and want to store sensitive content. Download and install software, specify yourself in seal option and mail Sealed and Encrypted file to yourself in less then a minute.
8. What kind of strong authentication should I specify for the recipient?
It depends on the content sensitivity and value: for moderate value – you may specify 2-factor authentication, for high-value – you may specify 3-factor authentication.

<i>option</i>	<i>authentication</i>	<i>Content value</i>
<i>Encrypt</i>	none	low
<i>Seal and Encrypt</i>	2-factor	moderate
<i>Seal and Encrypt</i>	3-factor	high

9. How should I specify the recipient?
You need to know recipient email within SentryCom system. If you are not sure- you should use our Address Book to verify user's email.



10. How will recipient know that the content is genuine and it is from me?

You will need to apply Sign & Encrypt Option. To apply this option you have to be registered.

11. What Sign means?

Sign means that signer needs to be authenticated in real-time.

12. Should I choose 2-tier or 3-tier authentication?

It depends on the content sensitivity and value: for moderate value – you may specify 2-factor authentication, for high-value – you may specify 3-factor authentication.

13 I want to sign number of files at once. What is the easy way?

ZIP your files together and sign ZIP.

14. I want my boss sign after me . What is the easy way?

Send him your signed file and ask him to sign it.

15. Should I be registered to view signed file?

No, anyone with software VoiceProof® software installed can view the signed file.

16. I want to combine Sign& Encrypt with Seal. OK?

OK..

17 .Could you summarize all the options available for content protection?
